RULES, BEHAVIOR & DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES



- ★ **BEHAVIOR:** You will be representing the Upper Darby High School and the Marching Royals at ALL times while on this trip. Not just when you are marching in the parade. So please be on your best behavior. We want everyone to have FUN and to enjoy themselves. Please use common sense when it comes to behavior and actions during this trip. If anything you do is not good for our school, DON'T DO IT!!!
- ★ **DISCIPLINE:** If you break any rules, you will be sent home IMMEDIATELY, at your own expense. In addition, any discipline that has to be taken will be followed up with the principal when we return to school.

IMPRESSIONS ARE MADE QUICKLY BY OTHERS OBSERVING YOUR ACTIONS AND ATTITUDES. A GREAT DEAL OF RESPONSIBILITY MUST BE SHOWN IN ORDER FOR THIS TRIP TO BE SUCCESSFUL. UNFORTUNATELY, AN INCIDENT OR DISREGARD FOR RULES COULD RUIN THE REPUTATION OF A FINE ORGANIZATION, LIKE THE UPPER DARBY MARCHING ROYALS.

1. The adults accompanying the group have the authority to question and correct your actions. Anything that falls into this area will be reported to Mr. Victor Cummings (Band Director) or Mr. Jason Moore (Assistant Band Director).
2. Members may not leave from large group functions (group meetings) until excused by Mr. Cummings or Mr. Moore, so that announcements can be made.
3. Be on time for all scheduled activities (i.e. meeting for Parade check-in, daily chaperone check-in, nightly room checks, meeting for departure, etc.) – Lateness is Rude!
4. Stay in small groups when in public. Anytime you leave your room (to go to the Parks, to the Food Court, to the Pool, etc.) you should always be with at least one other student or adult. **NEVER GO ANYWHERE BY YOURSELF!**
5. Members of the Band should not fraternize with persons other than our group. Stay away from strangers.
6. We do reserve the right to inspect your room or belongings at any time.
7. Girls and Boys are NOT permitted in each others' rooms at any time. NO EXCEPTIONS!
8. Room doors are to be locked at all times. Never open the door unless the voice on the other side is recognizable as a chaperone or staff member.
9. Lights-out times and checkout times will be strictly enforced. Lights-out means Lights Out, and Quiet means Quiet; there are other guests staying at the hotel.
10. Do not use the telephone in your room to make any local or long distance calls; the hotels often charge you. Only use the phones if you need to call another room.
11. Either use the room safes or keep your money and valuables with you. Do not leave money or valuables in your room when you are not in the room.
12. Please leave your room in the same condition in which you found it.
13. Anything that is the property of the hotel is not to be taken home with you.
14. All rooms are to be inspected by chaperones prior to departure from the hotel. Students will be held financially responsible for any expenses incurred due to damage to rooms or hotel property. Be sure to take ALL your belongings with you when you pack up. **DON'T FORGET YOUR PHONE CHARGERS!!!**

15. Absolutely NO FOUL language will be tolerated at ANY TIME! Seriously, it's Disney!!!
16. The use of or possession of alcoholic beverages or any illegal substance is prohibited. If you are found with any alcohol or drugs, you will be sent home. Smoking is not permitted at any time on this trip.
17. No use or possession of any fireworks, water balloons, or any other device which may cause injury to you or others.
18. Music may only be listened to with headphones or earbuds. No bluetooth or other type of speakers are permitted. No one is to spray perfumes, colognes, or hair spray in public areas, on the buses or the planes. Thank you!
19. No one is to spray perfumes, colognes, or hair spray in public areas, on the buses or the planes, Thank you!
20. Please keep the buses as clean as possible, especially if you are eating snacks. Always take your trash with you and dispose of it properly.
21. Breaking any of the above rules will result in being referred to your Principal, and/or being sent home. If you are referred to your Principal, the level violations in your student handbook will take effect.
